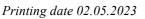

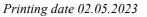

The glove material has to be impermeable and resistant to the product/ the substance/ the preparation. \cdot *Material of gloves*

The selection of the suitable gloves does not only depend on the material, but also on further marks of quality and varies from manufacturer to manufacturer.
